

Frequently Asked Questions and Fun Facts

General Questions:

- What time does the tournament start? Registration opens at 11:15am; Shotgun Scramble at 1:00pm
- What time should the players get there? Arriving at 11:30am will allow time to register, eat, and hit a few practice balls
